



## Examen de Certificación B1 – Examen Escrito

### Información para candidatos

**Destreza:** Expresión escrita

**Duración:** 60 minutos

**Número de tareas:** 2

#### **1ª Parte:**

Consiste en un texto como, por ejemplo, describir una experiencia o exponer una opinión.

La redacción debe tener entre 140-180 palabras.

El tiempo recomendado para esta tarea es de 35 minutos.

#### **2ª Parte:**

Consiste en escribir un email, formal o informal.

La redacción debe tener entre 130-160 palabras.

El tiempo recomendado para esta tarea es de 25 minutos

Se aconseja tomar notas o realizar un esquema antes de escribir la redacción, y se proporcionará papel para este propósito.

## **Ejemplos de tareas y modelos de respuestas.**

### **1ª Parte, entrada para un blog.**

#### **1ª Parte: Blog entry**

You have a travel blog for foreign visitors to Spain. You recently spent a day somewhere outside Madrid.

Write an entry for your blog in which you:

- describe your day.
- recommend the place.
- tell your readers about a possible problem.

Write a **blog entry** of between **140-180 words**.

Use the title "A PERFECT DAY IN.....".

## **Ejemplo de redacción**

### **A perfect day in the mountains**

*Welcome back to my blog! Today I'm going to tell you about a wonderful day I spent in the mountains north of Madrid.*

*My boyfriend and I got the train from Madrid to the little town of Cercedilla. From there we walked along the Camorritos road into the woods. We did an easy 3-hour walk, ate our sandwiches beside a little river and had a nap on a sunny rock. After that, we went back into the town for coffee and cakes in one of the cafés.*

*We had a great time. If you don't know this area you really should go one day. It's so close to Madrid, but it feels like a different world. The scenery is amazing, the air is clean and you are in contact with nature. There are easy walks for lazy people like me and much harder ones for experienced walkers.*

*There is one thing you should remember: to wear walking boots. If you don't your feet will suffer and you won't enjoy your day in the mountains.*

## **1ª Parte: Redacción**

## 2ª Parte: Correo electrónico (formal)
